And we ask for name and number exchange which looks a lot like a contest. On the other hand we encourage exchange of other information.

We feel it is better to be safe than sorry. So from now on, we ask you to respect the IARU recommendations for contest free band segments. Please use **3.550-3.560, 7.030-7.040 and 14.050-14.060 kHz** starting with the next party.

The purpose will remain the same: we want to stimulate activity in CW and we want you to have a nice QSO with you favorite key. It can be a normal QSO but if you feel you want to work as many members as you can in one hour please go ahead, as long as you are having fun!
