






- To Promote and Preserve the Art of CW in its Original Form by the use of Mechanical Keys
- Straight Key
- Bug (Semi-Automatic)
- Sideswiper (Cootie)
- "Key Policy Waiver" available for physical/ medical conditions









- Formed in January of 2006 following the Annual ARRL-Sponsored Straight Key Night (SKN)
- Started with a QRZ.com forum discussion with the intent of having a Straight Key Night every month
- Tom Petersen, KC9ECI, formed the Straight Key Century Club and became SKCC #1
- Within days there were well over 100 members
- Currently over 24,000 members world wide and growing daily



- Membership is free
- Open to any licensed Radio Amateur with an Interest in Mechanically Generated CW
- SKCC numbers are issued for life
- Incorporated and Approved under IRS Section 501(c)(3) Tax Exempt status in 2014





- SKCC welcomes all CW operators no minimum speed requirement
- Very Friendly Operators QRS if needed
- Short QSO or Rag Chew your choice
- Slow Speed Saunter Every Month (<12 wpm)





- New CW operators need a safe haven where they can get on the air and not have to worry about making mistakes
 - ✓ Maybe for that first CW contact without the stress or fear of worrying about fouling up
 - ✓ The goal is to take away that fear, because WE DON'T CARE IF YOU MESS UP!
 - ✓ The Straight Key becomes a great leveler few can do 20+ WPM on a straight key for too long




- SKCC's guiding philosophy is two-fold:
